

Nature and Raptor Center of Pueblo Fact Sheet

The Nature and Raptor Center of Pueblo is located in scenic Rock Canyon on the banks of the Arkansas River, one mile west of Pueblo, Colorado. The beautiful setting features a variety of facilities and nature programs year-round. The Raptor Center gives the public an opportunity to view live birds of prey including eagles, owls, hawks and falcons. Family nature programs are offered as well as summer day camps for youth. Environmental education programs are available for school groups. You can rent one of several spaces to hold a family reunion, wedding, meeting, or picnic. The gift shop in the Riverfront building offers a variety of nature gifts, field guides, bird feeders, and bird seed and also rents bicycles. Visitors can hike, bike, kayak, tube, canoe, jog, walk, rollerblade, bird watch, or simply enjoy the view. Daily admission is \$3 per vehicle, or visitors can become a member. Member benefits include: free parking, 10% discount on food and drink at the Coyote Grille restaurant, member-only events, Cottonwood newsletter, and benefits at over 140 participating Nature Centers in the U.S. and Canada.
